Wouldn't you like to be uninhibited to serve Christ more fully, without the distractions of unmerited stress and exhausting financial burdens? We want to help you offer your whole self to Christ even more profoundly – for you to be continually growing healthier and stronger spiritually, physically, mentally, and financially.

We have discovered a large list of financial pressures that undermine the effectiveness of pastoral leaders. This list includes; debt (educational, medical, other non-mortgage), healthcare costs (deductible and co-insurance liabilities), lack of emergency funds, planning for retirement, planning for children's education expenses, personal and parish budgeting and financial planning, and the culture and lack of awareness of our leadership in our communities about clergy finances. If any of the above addresses your needs then you may qualify for a Grant from the Clergy Initiative Program anywhere from \$1,000 to \$10,000.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Place your application for the clergy Initiative Grant by contacting Fr. Al Demos at <u>917-1842-9844</u> or <u>Fral@goarch.org</u> to register. You will need to fill out and return the **Section 2 Enrollment Questionnaire** and return it to Fr. Al.
- 2. Confirm your Archdiocesan status.
- 3. Once you are registered we will send the David Ramsey course to you.
- 4. Sign up online and complete the David Ramsey course *IMPORTANT!!!* DO NOT LOSE THE CODE NUMBER.
- 5. Use the Pete the Planner Program as our Financial Guide by signing up at: yourmoneyline.com/greekorthodox
- 6. Fulfill all required educational activities (Ramsey & Pete Planner).
- 7. Complete the initial financial consultation.
- 8. Fill out and submit the grant proposal form and explain how the grant will help you to confirm your financial need (debt, healthcare expenses, emergency expenses & retirement).
- 9. Send your full name, name on the account(s) to be paid, account number(s), amount(s) to be paid, and creditor's complete address where the grant is to be sent.
- 10. Review by the Committee. (We know that you would like to receive this grant as soon as possible, but please be aware that this process will take time, anywhere from one to two years to complete, depending upon each case, so please be patient be with us. We want to make sure that we help you as much as possible but please know that not all applicants are guaranteed \$10,000.)

The above statistics are required for our program from the Lilly Foundation. Two of us are the <u>only</u> persons who see all your *personal information*. The Committee only sees statistics, not your name or your private information!

Once I have this information, you will receive a packet in your email within a few weeks entitled the *Dave Ramsey Course of the Financial Peace University*. Please make sure that you also enroll in the Pete the Planner Program for financial guidance. You can easily participate in this guidance program by signing up for your account by email. Just to be more specific: everyone must participate in the Pete the Planner Program by internet and phone, in order for us to process your grant. Pete the Planner (Your Money Line) is primarily to be used **now in place of your financial adviser**, and you are free to utilize any other information in the program that is of interest to you. In time you may want to go over everything yourself, but it is **not necessary** to complete every aspect of Pete the Planner though it is loaded with helpful information that can only benefit your financial life.

You can easily participate in the program by signing up and registering for your account and by calling the financial helpline. They will send us a report on your progress.
